1. Presentation Schedule & Timing

- **Total Time Slot:** 20 minutes.
- **Presentation:** 10 minutes.
- **Q&A:** 10 minutes.
- **Punctuality:** Please join the online session at least 20 minutes before your scheduled session starts to test your audio, video, and screen sharing with the session moderator.

2. Technical Requirements

- **Platform:** The symposium will be hosted via **Google Meet**.
- **Meeting Link:** <https://meet.google.com/cao-oikp-ckt>
- **Internet Connection:** A stable, wired Ethernet connection is highly recommended. If using Wi-Fi, ensure you are close to the router.
- **Audio/Video:**
 - Use a dedicated headset or external microphone for clear audio.
 - Position your camera at eye level.
 - Ensure your face is well-lit from the front (avoid bright windows behind you).

3. Slide Preparation

- **Format:** 16:9 aspect ratio (Widescreen).
- **File Type:** PowerPoint (.pptx) or PDF.
- **Font Size:** Minimum 24pt for body text to ensure readability on small screens.
- **Visuals:** Use high-resolution images and simplify complex charts. Since this is a virtual session, avoid heavy animations that may lag over slow connections.
- **Backup:** Please email a copy of your slides to the organizing committee at **vkspe2026@ntu.edu.vn** by **January 25th, 2026**, as a technical backup.

4. During Your Presentation

- **Screen Sharing:** Share your "Window" (the PowerPoint application) rather than your entire "Desktop" to prevent private notifications from appearing.
- **Engagement:** Look directly into the camera lens while speaking to maintain "eye contact" with the audience.
- **Environment:** Present from a quiet, professional environment. Use a neutral or symposium-branded virtual background if available.
- **Notifications:** Silence your mobile phone and turn off computer notifications (Email, Zalo, Slack, etc.) before starting.

5. Emergency Procedures

- If your connection drops, try to rejoin immediately using the same link.
- If you cannot reconnect, the Session Chair may move to the next presenter and return to you at the end of the session.
